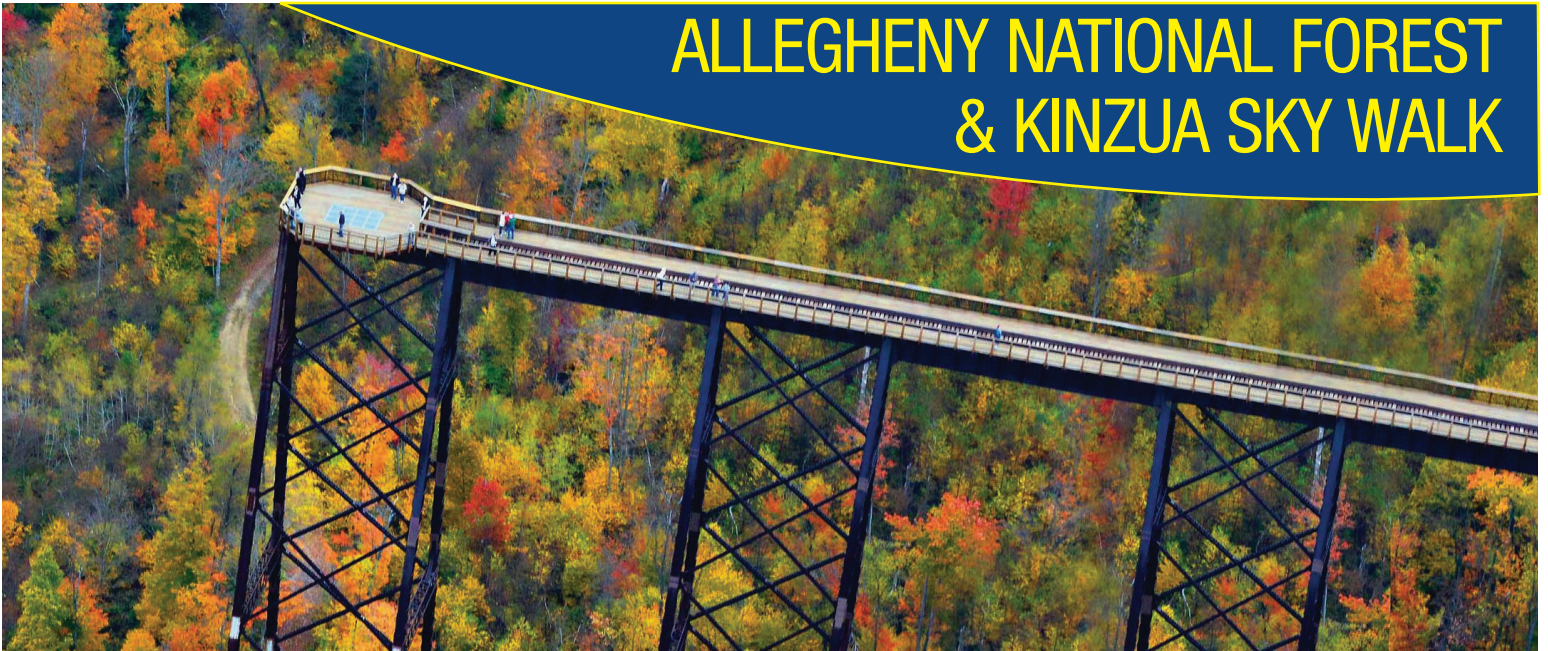

Kinzua Sky Walk

The skywalk is 624 feet long, 225 feet high with a partial glass floor, providing 360-degree views of the Kinzua Gorge. It was built on six of the historic Kinzua Viaduct towers left standing, following a tornado on July 21, 2003. When built in 1882, the Kinzua Viaduct was the highest and longest railroad viaduct in the world.



Allegheny National Forest

Having celebrated its 100th anniversary in 2023, two centennial challenges – a 100-mile hiking challenge and a geo-trail continue until Sept. 24, 2024. The Forest offers cabins, along with more than 1,000 camp sites, within 14 campgrounds, with over 600 miles of trails. Trails include mountain biking, hiking, biking, ATV and snowmobiling.



Small Towns, Big History

Each small town has significant world history! From the colorful Bucktails of Civil War fame, the saving of the Lobo Wolves from extinction, to the discovery of the world's first billion-dollar oil field. Where else, except in Bradford, will you find the Zippo/Case, an opera, and an oil museum in the same town?



Art in the Wilds

This annual juried art show will be held June 23-24, 2024 in Evergreen Park, Kane, PA. A signature artisan event for the Pennsylvania Wilds Region. This show features fine art, photography, weaving, jewelry, and pottery. Plus decorative items crafted from the heartwood of trees harvested locally.



Wilds Sonshine Factory

Opened in 2023, the Wilds Sonshine Factory is a distillery crafting spirits from sunflowers grown in PA. At this agricultural education center learn about the natural resources of timber, water, and agriculture via interpretive displays and guided tours. Tasting Room. Sunflower Fields. Gift Shop.



Eldred WW II Museum

Living History Weekends, May 18-19 and Sept 21-22, 2024. The museum hosts WWI and WWII reenactors from Canada, Ohio, New York and PA. Outside of the museum, a M551 Sheridan Tank appears to be bursting through the brick wall. Inside, is a working submarine telescope, interactive exhibits, and stories of the men and women who have fought to protect America's freedom.



Zippo/Case Museum

The Zippo/Case Museum has undergone a major renovation. This museum highlights the unique history of two iconic, made in America products, the Zippo lighter and the Case knife. The 15,000 sq. foot museum offers interactive exhibits plus their flagship store. It is located in the city where the Zippo lighter was invented – Bradford, PA



Knox & Kane Rail Trail

This trail connects the Kinzua Bridge State Park to Mt. Jewett, Lantz Corners, Kane and will later this year connect to Russell City. The trail is open for biking, hiking, and also in some sections snowmobiling. New trail miles will link the Kinzua Valley Trail and Red Bridge Campground, in the ANF, to the Knox & Kane.
