## Allegheny National Forest Region


### Like winding roads and scenic byways?

Seeking an area where one car in front of you at a stop sign is considered “heavy” traffic? In the Allegheny National Forest Region the colors of nature will surround you.

Traverse through forestlands, farmlands, and quaint villages along the Longhouse National Scenic Byway, the Kinzua Bridge Scenic Byway and Pennsylvania Route 6. Marvel at the Kinzua Sky Walk, a scenic wonder, as the scenic beauty unfolds along your journey.

### Driving Tours in the Allegheny National Forest

Check into your lodging in Bradford, PA, which will become your center for adventure while touring the region.

**DAY 1:** Drive to the **Kinzua Bridge State Park** and the **Kinzua Sky Walk** to learn the amazing history of the skywalk, while enjoying amazing views. Lunch at the **Barrel House Restaurant & Tavern** in Lantz Corners a family owned local restaurant. In the afternoon visit **Kane and Bell’s Meat & Poultry Shop** an old-fashioned family-owned general store with meats, cheeses and specialty foods. Bring a cooler! Next stop, **The Sweet Shoppe** for some gelato and handmade artisan chocolates. Two choices for sampling and sipping; **CJ Spirits** – a craft distillery for rum, vodka, gin and white whiskey, or **Flickerwood Wine Cellars** to sample their award winning wines.

**DAY 2:** First stop the **Zippo/Case Museum** where you’ll learn the story of these two American Icons, enjoy shopping their flagship gift shop. On to the **Penn Brad Oil Museum** and the world’s first billion dollar oil field. Lunch and shop in downtown **Bradford’s National Historic District**. Depart for **Smethport’s Mansion District** and take the self-guided walking tour. The **Old Jail Museum** has a resident ghost! It’s on to **Eldred** and the **WW II Museum** where you can see, feel and touch history. Plan a stop on the way back to Bradford at the **Old School House Village Shoppes**, over 12,000 square feet of unique shopping.

**DAY 3:** Begin your morning with a pastry from **John Williams Pastry Shop**. Have the **Grocery Stretcher** pack you a picnic lunch from their selection of Amish cheese and meats. Enjoy a short hike around the **Marilla Reservoir** which features stunning scenery and a wooden covered bridge. In the afternoon, drive into the Allegheny National Forest and explore the beauty of Rimrock Overlook, Kinzua Point and the Kinzua Dam as you circle the Allegheny Reservoir on the Longhouse National Scenic Byway.
