

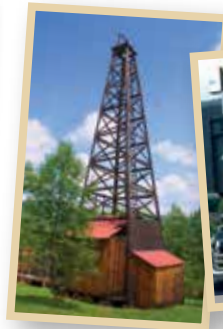
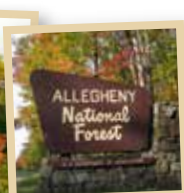
ALLEGHENY NATIONAL FOREST & KINZUA SKY WALK

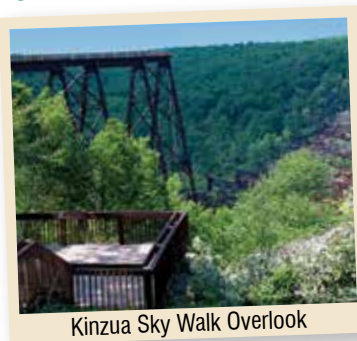

Kinzua Sky Walk – Day Trip or Overnight

Start your morning with a trip to the amazing **Kinzua Sky Walk** – “Walk the Tracks Across the Sky.” Book a free park program at the Kinzua Bridge Visitors Center with park staff. Free Admission. In the afternoon enjoy, **Enchante’ Cabaret Dinner Theater** at the historic Beefeaters Restaurant. Overnight at the Best Western Bradford Inn. Tour the new **Marilyn Horne Opera Museum** in the morning.

American Made, American Proud

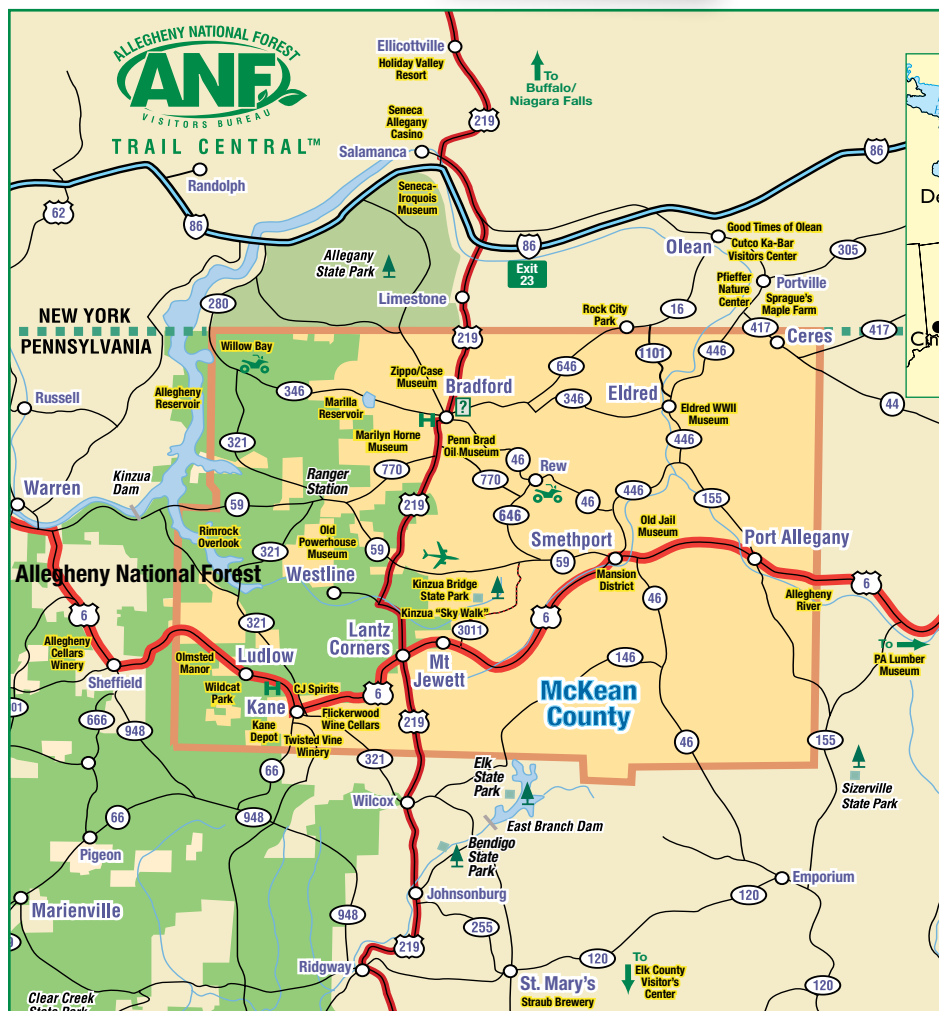
