### DRIVING DIRECTIONS

**Eldred WWII Museum** → **Penn Brad Oil Museum**= 27 min (18.6 miles)

Head north on Main St toward Central St for 0.5 miles, turn left and head west onto PA-346 toward Bradford for 11.1 miles, use the right lane to take the ramp onto PA-346 W/US-219 S, continue to head south on US-219 for 5.3 miles. The Penn Brad Oil Museum will be on your left.

**Penn Brad Oil Museum** → **Beefeaters Restaurant**= 6 min (3.4 miles)

Head north on US-219 for 2.8 miles, take the Elm St exit, turn left onto Elm St for 0.2 miles, turn right onto Congress St. Beefeaters Restaurant will be on your right.

**Beefeaters Restaurant** → **Bestwestern Plus Bradford Inn**=2 min (0.3 miles)

From Beefeaters Restaurant head south on Congress St toward East Corydon St, turn left onto East Corydon St, turn right onto Chestnut St, turn left onto Elm St. Bestwestern Plus Bradford Inn will be on your left.

**Bestwestern Plus Bradford Inn** → **Zippo/Case Museum**= 3 mins (0.8 miles)

From Bestwestern head southwest on Elm St, turn left at the 1st cross street onto Chestnut St, continue on Chestnut St for 0.7 miles, turn right onto Zippo Dr, the Zippo/Case Museum will be on your right.

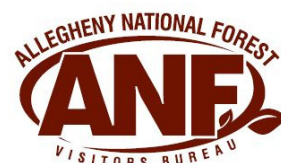
