

Adventures in the ANF Region - 3 Days & 2 Nights

Kinzua Sky Walk - Allegheny National Forest - Oil - Opera - Seneca Nation

DAY ONE

Travel along the Longhouse National Scenic Byway – "One of the Top 50 Most Scenic Drives in America." – USA Today. The forest is a colorful patchwork of scarlet, sunshine yellow and vivid orange. The brilliant colors are reflected in the waters of the Allegheny Reservoir. Touring along the eastern shoreline, plan your photo stops at Kinzua Dam, Kinzua Point, and Rimrock Overlook. Prime leaf peeping is usually the first two weeks of October.

Next stop is the **Bradford Ranger Station** for a quick overview of the **Allegheny National Forest.** Their gift shop features a variety of Smokey the Bear items and nature themed gifts. Public restrooms are available.

Dine at **Kane Manor Inn**, this national historic landmark was built by the family of General Thomas L. Kane. The views of the nearby countryside are breathtaking. Motorcoach menus available.

Next, drive along scenic Rt. 6 to the **Kinzua Sky Walk** – "One of the World's Top 10 Most Scenic Skywalks," – *Culture Trip, U.K.* Schedule a **Park Program**. Open daily year-round. Free admission and free park programs with prior arrangement.

Travel Rt. 6 to Smethport to visit **Old Town Smethport**. Tour the displays including an original stagecoach and Civil War cannon. Then shop at **America's First Christmas Store** and the **General Store** or enjoy a cocktail or dessert at **Cottage House Restaurant**, all conveniently located at one site. Admission and parking are free.

Drive to Bradford, check in at the **Best Western Plus Bradford Inn** for two nights. **Dinner on your own.** A variety of restaurants are within walking distance, as is the **Main Street Movie House**. A bar and pub restaurant are located on site. Enjoy a hot breakfast served in the morning. Motorcoach Ready.

DAY TWO

First stop in the morning, the guided tour at the Zippo/Case Museum & Flagship Store. The Zippo lighter was invented in Bradford, and it is one of the two American icons – the Zippo lighter and the Case knife still "Made in America". Add a personal touch to your souvenir or gift with on-the-spot engraving at the gift shop. Free Admission.

Explore and shop in **Bradford's National Historic District**. Use the self-guided tour brochure to learn the history of the eclectic architecture of the buildings built in 1800 and 1900s during Bradford's oil boom days. Shop at the multi-vendor 10,000 sq. ft. **Main Street Mercantile**, the **Little Fabric Garden**, the **Grocery Stretcher** for Amish meats & cheeses, or indulge in creamy fudge and pastries made at **John Williams European Pastry Shop**.

Lunch at **Beefeaters Restaurant**, a renovated historic Carnegie Library. The building is listed on the National Historic Registry. Private dining room. Motorcoach menus available. American cuisine.

After lunch, travel to the **Penn Brad Oil Museum**, where you will enjoy "Wild Catting Tales" of the first billion-dollar oil field in the world. Tour the 72-foot tall, 1890 era standard rig, and enjoy a short film in the "Doghouse" theater.

Return to the Best Western Plus Hotel Bradford Inn to relax and get ready for your "Evening at the Museum." Enjoy a private tour of the **Marilyn Horne Museum**, followed by an intimate dining experience in the museum's elegant theater. Their staff will work with you to create a curated experience for your group.

DAY THREE

Travel to Salamanca, NY, to visit the Seneca-Iroquois National Museum and Onohsagwe:de Cultural Center. Learn about their history and culture through exhibits, traditionally crafted items including antler carvings, ornate beadwork and visit a replica Longhouse. Group tour ready with advanced notice.

Next stop, Jamestown, NY. Here you can visit the **Lucy-Desi Museum** and/or the **National Comedy Center** before heading home from a memorable tour of the Allegheny National Forest Region.
