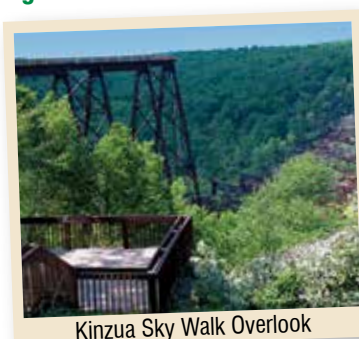

Sample Itineraries

Kinzua Sky Walk – Day Trip or Overnight

Start your morning with a trip to the amazing **Kinzua Sky Walk** – “Walk the Tracks Across the Sky.” Schedule a free park program at the **Kinzua Bridge Visitors Center** with park staff. Free Admission. In the afternoon book a **Bradford National Historic District Walking Tour** and taste and tour at the new craft brewery – **Bradford Brew Station**. Overnight at the Best Western Plus Bradford Inn. Tour the new **Marilyn Horne Museum** in the morning.



Kinzua Sky Walk Overlook

Fall in the Allegheny National Forest

Cruise along the **Longhouse National Scenic Byway** with your step-on-guide. Scenic stops include the Allegheny Reservoir, Kinzua Dam and Rimrock Overlook. Lunch at **Kane Manor**, tour the **Kane Depot/McCleery Discovery Center**. In the afternoon, travel to the amazing **Kinzua Sky Walk**, and enjoy a nature program at the Kinzua Bridge State Park.

Arrive in time for a luncheon and hands-on **Baking Class at John Williams European Pastry Shop**. Then off to **CJ Spirits** for a tour and tasting at their craft distillery. Finish your day with wine tasting and an authentic Italian meal at **Flickerwood Wine Cellars** in Kane.

History & Heros

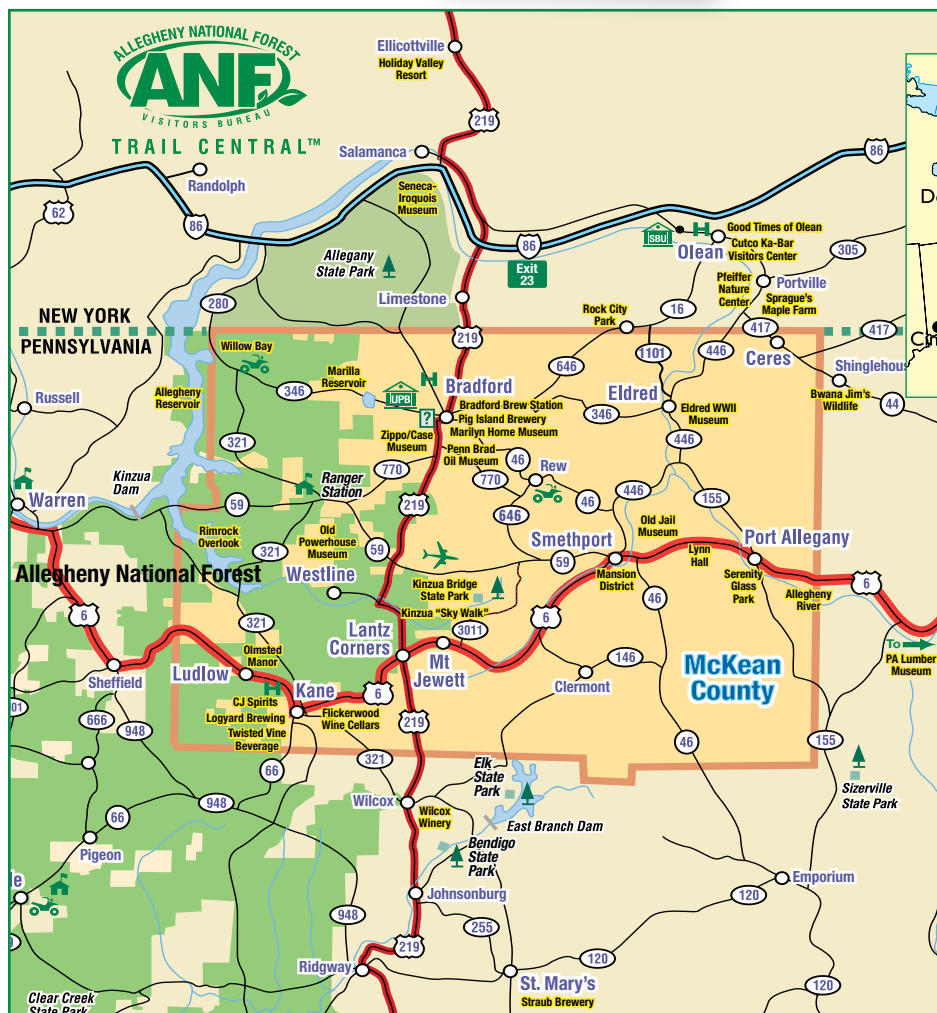
Bradford's history as a rich oil boom town of the late 1800s is showcased at the **Penn Brad Oil Museum**. The Zippo lighter, invented in Bradford, is the story told at the **Zippo/Case Museum** where you can shop for Zippo lighters and Case knives. Within **Bradford's National Historic District** enjoy a dinner theater performance at **Beefeaters Restaurant**. In the morning, learn about America's heroes at the **Eldred WW II Museum**, then travel to the site of the tornado of 2001—where the **Kinzua Sky Walk** was re-invented from the historic 1882 Kinzua Viaduct.
